

Lesson 10 - The Covenant of Circumcision

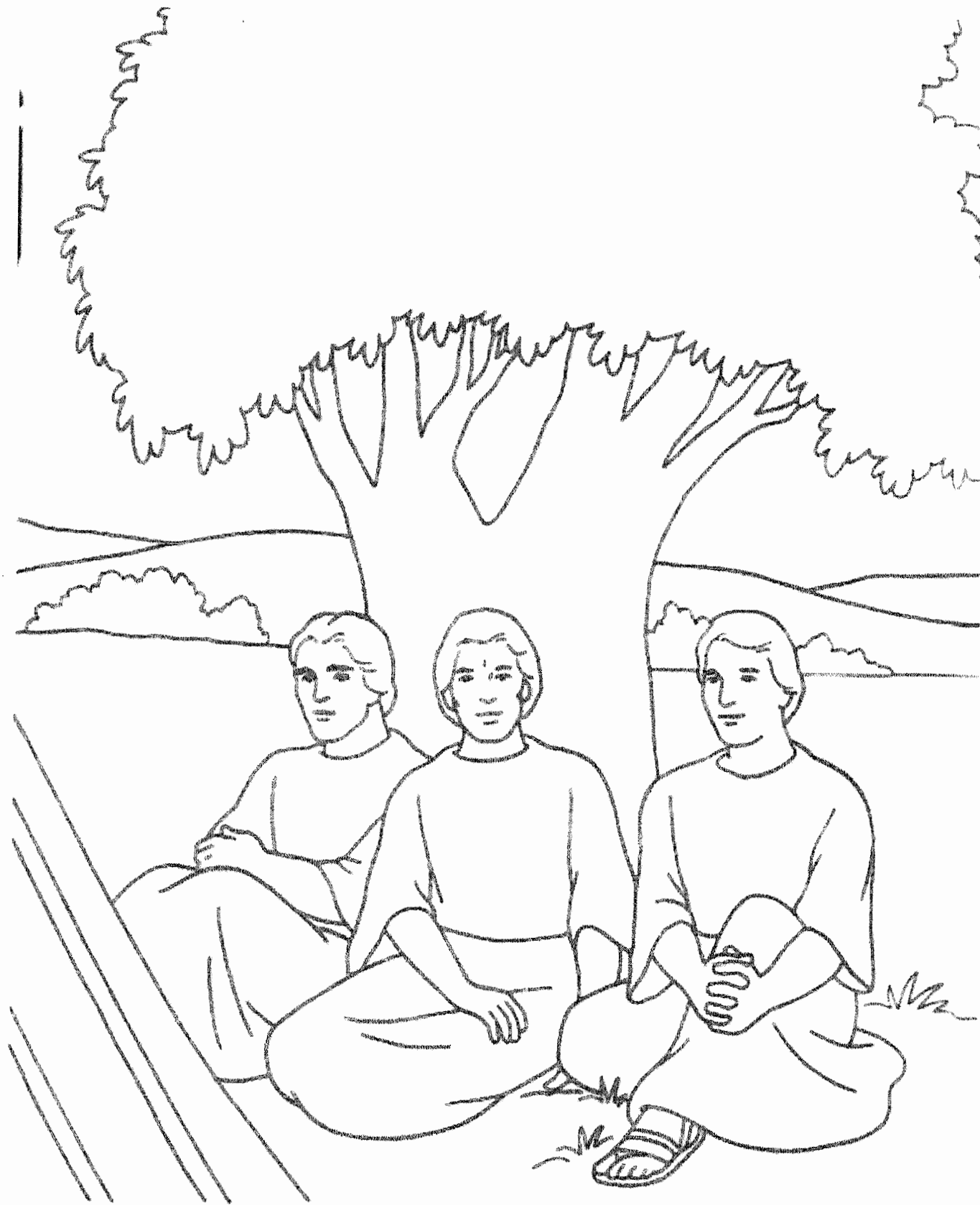
Genesis 17-18

Key Verse

Genesis 17:9, “And God said to Abraham: ‘As for you, you shall keep My covenant, you and your descendants after you throughout their generations.’”

Key Points

2. Abram and Sarah had laughed about the promise and doubted they would have a son.
3. God changed Abram and Sarah’s names.
4. Abram was kind and generous to strangers.
5. God knew that Sarah laughed even though she did it in private.
6. God listened to Abraham’s petition and showed mercy to Lot.



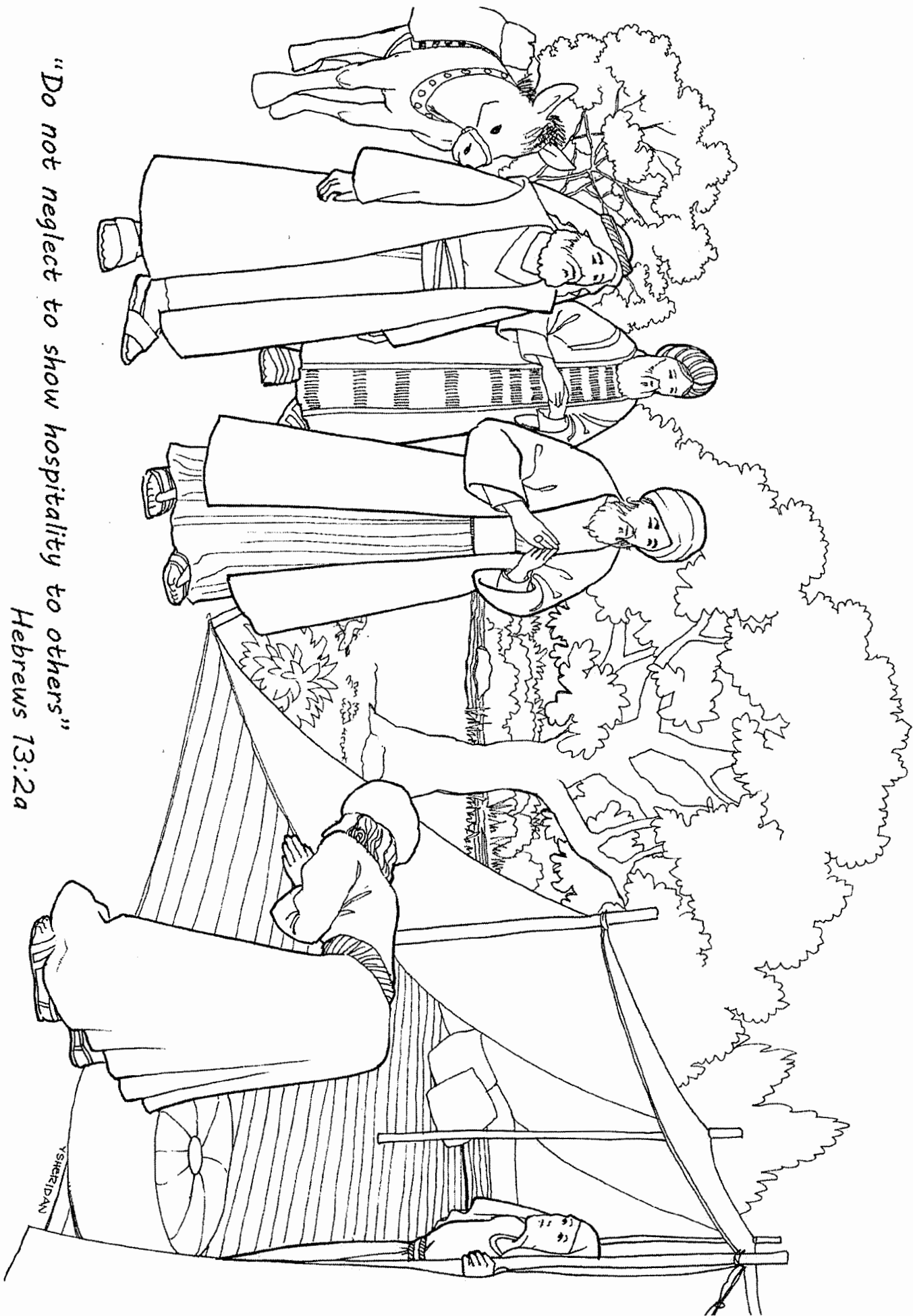

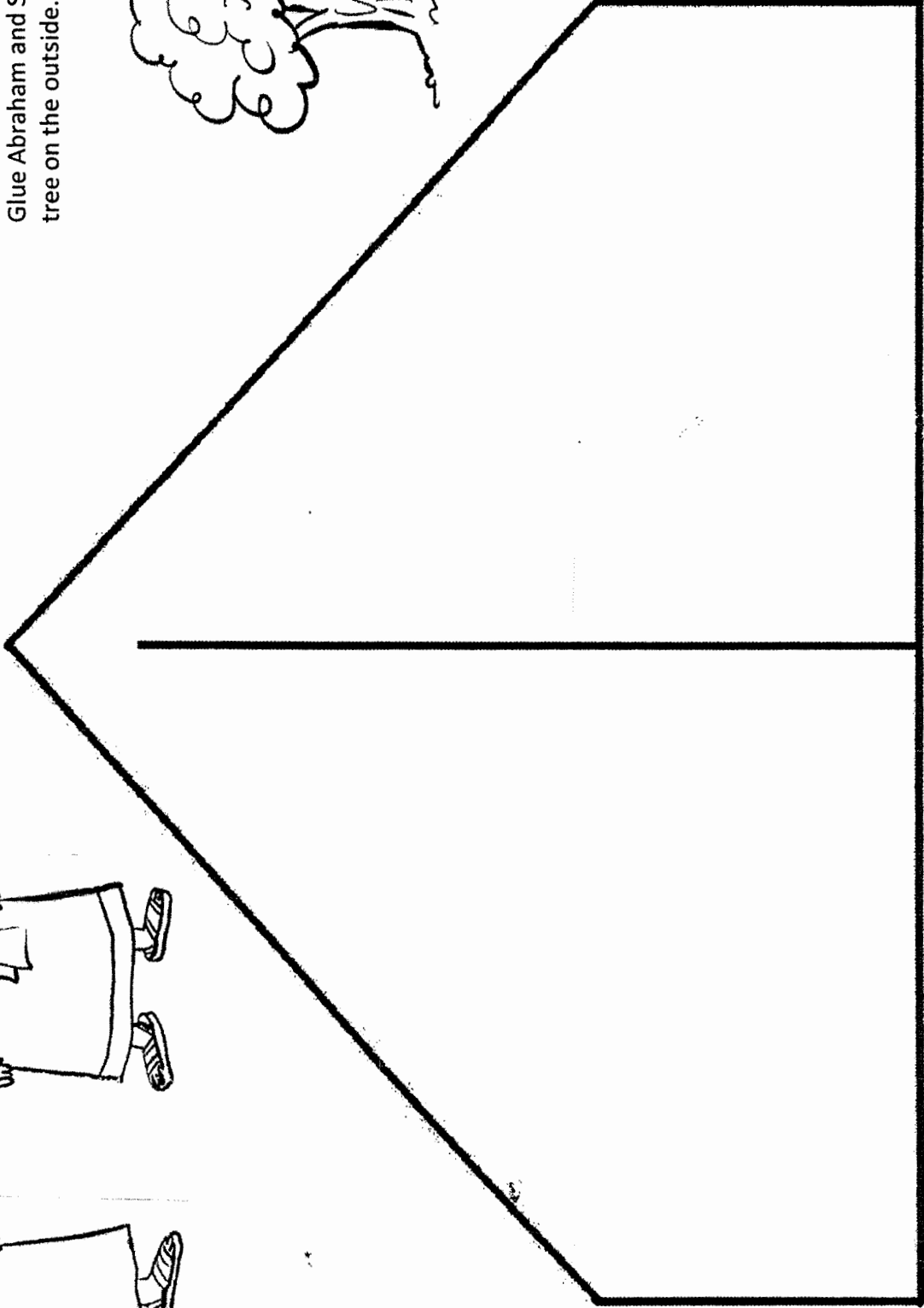
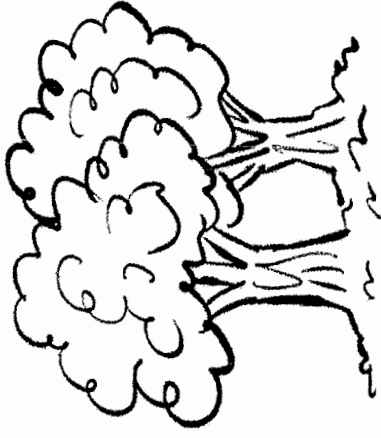
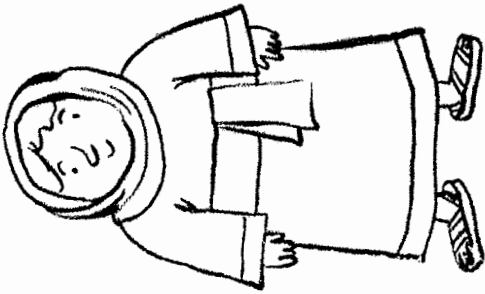
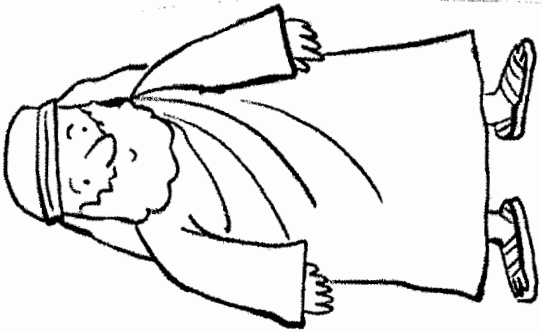
Cut tent from cardstock.

Have children color and cut out.

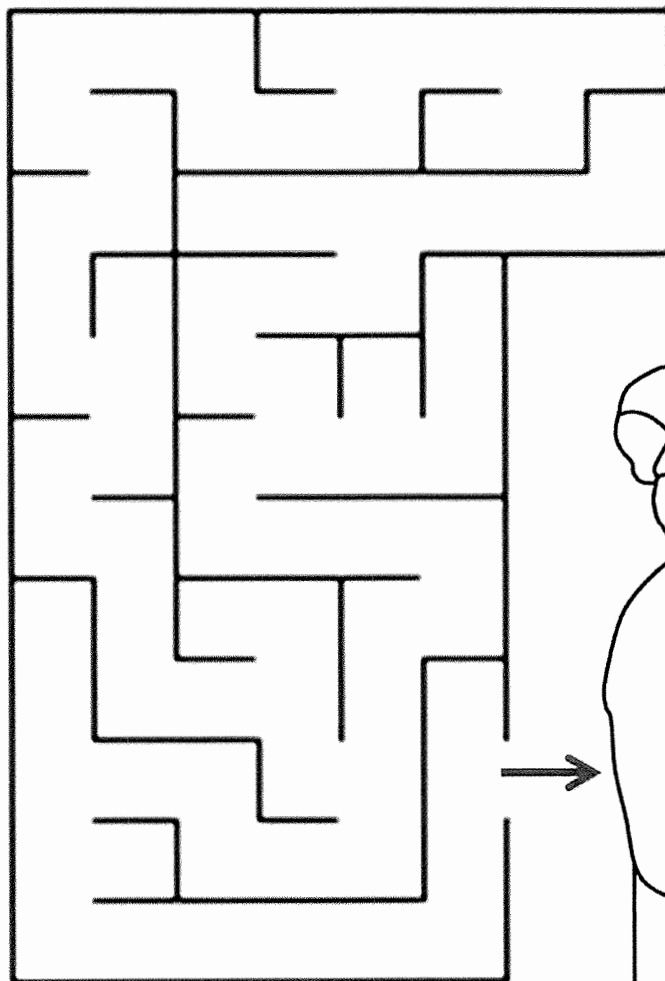
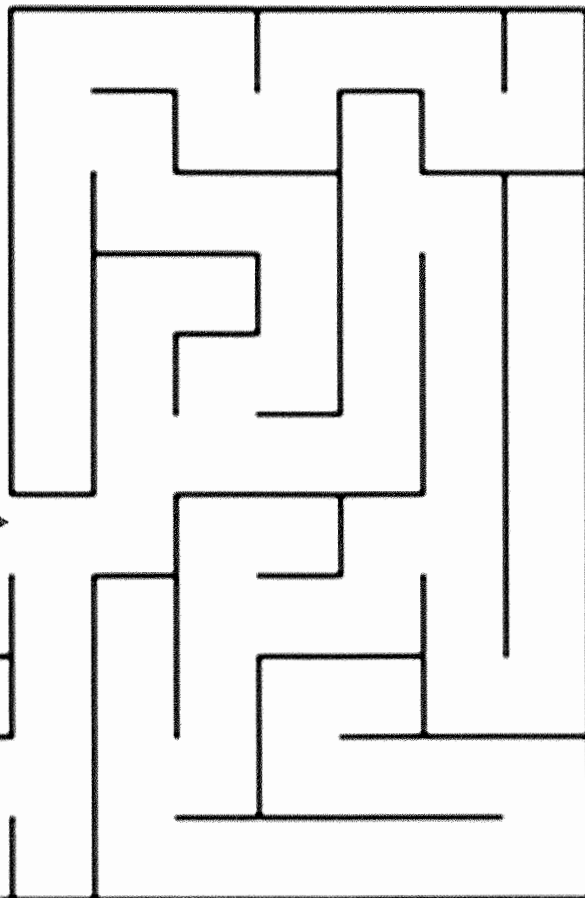
Cut slit in the tent, fold back.

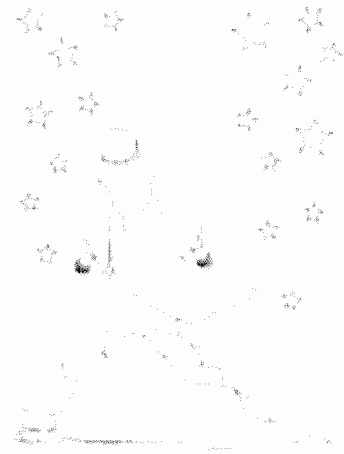

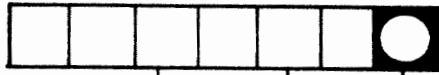

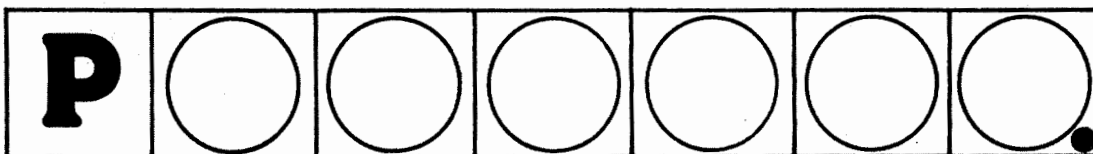
