3. What happened to the walls of Jericho after the Israelites followed God's instructions, and what was the outcome for the city?
4. Who was spared during the destruction of Jericho, and why was this person and their family saved?

1. What sin did Achan commit that led to Israel's defeat at Ai, and how was this discovered?
2. What was Joshua's reaction to the defeat at Ai, and how did he seek guidance from God?
3. What instructions did God give Joshua to address the sin within Israel, and what process was used to identify the guilty party?

4. What was the outcome for Achan and his family after his sin was exposed, and what does this event illustrate about obedience and consequences?

Joshua 8

1. What strategy did God give Joshua for the conquest of Ai, and how did it differ from the initial attack?
2. How did Joshua and the Israelites execute the ambush against Ai, and what resulted from their efforts?
3. What did the Israelites do with the king of Ai and the city itself after they captured it?
4. After the victory at Ai, what specific actions did Joshua take to renew the covenant with God, and where did this ceremony occur?
5. How do the events and outcomes in Joshua 6-8 illustrate the themes of obedience and disobedience to God's commands, and what can we learn from Joshua's leadership through success and failure?
6. How can the principles of obedience to God's guidance and accountability for one's actions, as demonstrated in Joshua 6-8, be applied to your personal life?
