- 5. What happens to the child born to David and Bathsheba, and how does this event affect David?
- 6. How does David console Bathsheba after their child's death, and what is the outcome of their union afterward?
- 7. Describe the military victory at Rabbah. How does it relate to the overall narrative of David's kingship?
