7. What is Bathsheba's reaction to Uriah's death, and what happens to her afterward?

2. How does David initially respond to Nathan's parable, and what does Nathan declare to David afterward?

4. How does David respond upon realizing the gravity of his sin, and what is Nathan's immediate reply?
5. What happens to the child born to David and Bathsheba, and how does this event affect David?
6. How does David console Bathsheba after their child's death, and what is the outcome of their union afterward?
7. Describe the military victory at Rabbah. How does it relate to the overall narrative of David's kingship?
